

Time to Rest on Our Laurels

(Pastor's note: I acknowledge that this piece was inspired by an article from Ministry Matters by Rebekah Simon-Peter. I thank her for her words!)

In Ancient Greece, victorious athletes were presented with laurel wreaths to wear. They were, and still are, signs of great accomplishment, unless you start resting on them. To 'rest on your laurels' means that you get lazy or complacent about what you could achieve because you're too busy basking in the memories of former glories. — Rebekah Simon-Peter



I would like to make a case for the practice of resting on our laurels here at First Church this summer. How can we truly know what's been accomplished if we don't pause, communicate and celebrate what has taken place in the past year?
