Word from the Pastor

Now, I really believe the oft quoted idiom, "Time flies when you are having fun." My ministry with First Church hasn't all been fun; some of it has been challenging, including the drive from my home in Manchester, and the return to weekly sermon preparation; but, like the Julie Andrews character sang in the movie "The King And I,"

Getting to know you, Getting to know all about you. Getting to like you, Getting to hope you like me.

The thing that has been most fun has been discovering that my initial anxieties about coming to serve as your interim pastor, ended when I was warmly welcomed; and the fun continues as I repeatedly encounter the flexibility, efficiency, and kindness of your leadership team, and the faithfulness and dedication of the membership.

Here we are already in Advent, swiftly wending our way towards our Christmas Eve service. For me and my family, Christmas is one of the most funfilled, joyous, and faith-inducing periods of the calendar, and so I look forward to sharing it with you.

On Sunday, December 9th, the children's message was titled, "The Promised Time Is At Hand" based on Luke 3:4b-6: "Prepare the way of the LORD, make his paths straight. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be made low, and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough ways made smooth; and all flesh shall see the salvation of GOD."

In the children's message, I showed them the attached picture of the Sagrada Familia Church in Barcelona, Spain, and pointed out the scaffolding on two sections of the roof. The church has been under construction since 1882; yet today, the church is just a little more than halfway done, they hope to with complete construction by 2026.

The prophet, John the Baptist, challenges us to prepare the way of the LORD, to make HIS paths straight,

to fill in all valleys, to level all hills and mountains, and to straighten the crooked roads, and smooth out all rough places.

I suggested to the children that Christians are urged to prepare the way of the LORD; and that no matter how much the Christian Church has accomplished in 2000 years, there is much more work to be done to prepare for the second coming of the LORD.

Church, set your clocks to Advent mode. Keep waiting, keep praying, and keep doing the ministry that draws women, men, girls, and boys to worship and serve the LORD JESUS CHRIST, the LORD OF LORDS and KING OF KINGS.

John Eggering makes them all sound amazing!



ADVENT TRADITIONS



The Advent wreath first appeared in Germany in 1839. A Lutheran minister working at a mission for children created a wreath out of the wheel of a cart. He placed twenty small red candles and four large white candles inside the ring. The red candles were lit on weekdays and the four white candles were lit on Sundays.

Eventually, evergreen wreaths replaced the cart wheel symbolizing everlasting life in the midst of winter and death. The circle reminds us of God's unending love and the eternal life He makes possible.

The four weeks of Advent are broken down into the themes:

Hope (or promise)
Preparation (waiting or prophecy)
Joy (peace)
Love (adoration)

In our tradition, the first, second, and fourth candles are purple; the third candle is pink and a fifth white candle is placed in the middle and is lit on Christmas Eve to celebrate Jesus' birth.
