Yesterday, I found myself in the waiting room of the Cancer Center on Kennedy Drive in Torrington. I had taken someone there for their regular appointment. You know me, as I sat there I struck up a conversation with a lovely lady. We started talking about all kinds of ordinary, everyday things and then she shared about why she was at the Cancer Center. As we were talking about doctors and holistic approaches a couple of women chimed in. I found myself in a sort of ad hoc support group.

This was one of those life changing conversations. Here were three very strong, very brave, very intelligent women who were long time battlers of cancer. They were frank and forthright in their comments and started to network with each other about resources and websites. They were also women of great faith and we ended up on each other's prayer lists.

I get caught up in my daily life, like we all do. I complain and worry about my over-busy schedule and how tired I am. And then God pulls me into His presence. Yesterday it was in the waiting room of the Cancer Center. HOPE and MERCY gushed out and surrounded us. God was clearly in that place.

I was reminded of the privilege God has given me to be a listener. I get to listen to such powerful stories of faith. There is no pretense or drama; just the simplicity of living as a follower.

But this year I am counting them differently. In the face of all the tragedy and violence and just plain raw meanness that has shown its ugly face in our world this year, I am grateful that God continually is present, showing me how to live with grace and mercy and hope.

Plastic window coverings will be used to try to help seal out some drafts this winter.


