#### **Word From The Pastor**

Last month, First Church was engaged in reaching members and friends to participate in the **Holy Cow** survey process. Thankfully, we received 44 or more responses to the Holy Cow surveys. On behalf of the Pulpit Committee, I thank all who completed a survey.

Today, I want to suggest a new thought as we wend our way to on our search for the next settled pastor. Welcome to "*Wholly Church!*" To appreciate *Wholly Church*, consider the verses printed below from Paul's letters to the Philippians and to the Ephesians.

"My dear, dear friends! I love you so much. I do want the very best for you. You make me feel such joy, fill me with such pride. Don't waver. Stay on track, steady in God." Philippians 4:1, 4-5 (The Message).

"Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work." Ephesians 4:15 (The Message).

In the verses from Philippians, Paul writes to the congregation that he loved dearly. He loved them for several reasons, including their faithfulness to the gospel, their commitment to the church, the spread of the gospel, and their care for one another. I also confess my personal love for you as a congregation, for your faithful care for one another, your demonstrated love for one another, your dedication to worship, your commitment to service, and your determination to maintain the life and wellbeing of First Church. That describes a *Wholly Church;* a church that is all about being whole and complete in the things of Christ. It also describes the effort to be utterly, unconditionally committed to stay the course as a living organism determined to thrive.

If First Church is to achieve the goal of securing a settled pastor, and of fulfilling your goal of numeric growth, spiritual growth, meeting the financial needs of the church, and to lengthening your years as a congregation, then more of you need to be committed to being **Wholly Church**. We recognize that some of you have taken leave from the fellowship, we hope temporarily; but if it is permanent, we hope that you are being fed with the word and empowered to serve the Lord. If your absence is temporary, we miss you all, and hope that you'll return soon.

Beyond that, *Wholly Church* is also an invitation for all members and friends of First Church to look closely at ourselves, our families, fellow members, and friends and realize as Paul wrote in Ephesians 4:15 "Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. 16 From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work." In other words, Paul wants us to grow and mature in him.

Paul wants us to recognize that each individual in the church is part of the body, as such, in order

to be **Wholly Church**, we need to join together and be held together, with the love of Christ serving as our binding agent. Pictured on this page is part of the new outer wall of the church. None of those stones are the same as the others. Each stone could represent individual members, the point being that now, they are joined to other stones and have become a wall. The stones are each different, regardless of their size, length of membership years, or spiritual gifts, but when we join together, each stone supports and strengthens the whole wall, and we can build ourselves up in love, as each part does its work. **You** are needed to help First Church rebuild and strengthen the rest of the congregation. You are needed to help us become **Wholly Church**.



#### **Pathways Capital Project Report:**

- Sewer connection was completed outside because the it couldn't be connected to the interior plumbing. Project going very well.
- The shed has been removed, and the back wall will now be completed.
- ❖ The roof is being replaced now, not just the window over the bathroom area, but the entire roof.
- Write Way Sign will be making the windows to fill the window openings in the wall using pictures of some of our stained-glass. These windows will be filling in space where they didn't have enough stone. They will not be true windows and will not be seen from the inside. There will be sheet rock on the inside.
- Front Line Electric donated electric for the rest room.
- ❖ The ramp will be solid concrete with a black aluminum railing which will be added before the final concrete is poured.
- Paving will happen the following week.
- Front sidewalk will be done in December.
