#### Word From The Pastor, October 2019



I write to encourage all members and friends of First Church to complete the Congregational Assessment Tool (whether online or on paper). So far, we have received less than 25 surveys. Without these surveys, our work will be impeded. Surveys and the results are produced by a nationally reputable firm.

Some have wondered about the use of the term, "Holy Cow!" Holy Cow! Consulting Services describes their work this way, "For over 25 years, we have been helping organizations determine where they are in order to help them get to where they need to be." "Holy Cow! Consulting," explains their name this way:

Envelopes with individual copies of the CAT are in the Gathering Room, beside a sealed box where all completed surveys may be confidentially returned, all surveys will be handled with strictest privacy & confidentiality. We have entered into a covenant relationship with Holy Cow, and are assured that all surveys submitted in sealed envelopes will be processed solely by the staff of Holy Cow! Consulting. When all surveys are processed and evaluated, First Church will receive coded responses, that a trained Holy Cow consultant will guide us interpreting and taking next steps.

If we don't understand ALL needs, hopes, and concerns, we will be challenged in our work to seek the next "settled Pastor" of First Church, who will guide the future steps of our congregation. Your observations and comments will help the Pulpit Committee to identify the next pastor, and together, we can all able to shout, "Holy Cow!"

As your Interim Pastor, I personally look forward to joining you in shouting:

First Church, we need your full participation to help select our next pastor; then, we will not only say, "Holy Cow!", but our neighbors will peak their ears to understand the loud shouting exiting each of our open windows and doors as they hear us shouting other phrases like:

- Photo ID or parent/guardian
- Proof of Residency for all Adults
- Proof of Children (Social Security Cards or Birth Certificates

#### Holiday Toys for children requirements:

- Children ages birth 14 yrs.
- Children must be living in the home of and in the care of the person signing up for the gifts. If other than parent, guardian must bring proof of guardianship.
