Mayonnaise Cake

This mayonnaise cake will beat out any of your other chocolate cake recipes!

INGREDIENTS

- 1 ½ cups of mayonnaise
- 3 cups flour
- 1 1/2 cups sugar
- 1/₃ cup cocoa
- 2 1/4 teaspoons of baking powder
- 1 ½ teaspoons of baking soda
- 1 ½ teaspoons of vanilla extract
- 1 ½ cups of water

DIRECTIONS

- Grease two cake pans (9 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$) and heat oven to 350 degrees.
- In a large bowl mixed together the flour, sugar, cocoa, baking powder, and baking soda).
- Add in the mayonnaise and stir to combine. Slowly stir in the water.
- Finally add in the vanilla extract and stir until smooth.
- Pour mixtures equally into both pans.
- Bake for 30 minutes or until you can insert a toothpick and have it come out clean. Remove from oven and allow to cool.
- Finish with your favorite chocolate icing. Enjoy!

Carmel fudge icing

1\3 cup butter

1 cup brown sugar(firmly packed)

1\4 cup milk

Over very low heat. Stir and bring to boil (boil 2 min.). cool until hand can be held on bottom pan. Stir in 2cups powdered sugar one at a time.

Add 1 1\2 T vanilla. beat until smooth and creamy.
